



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LITERACY SUPPORT CASE STUDY

OSWALD ROAD PRIMARY SCHOOL

Oswald Road Primary School recently worked with One Education's Literacy Team on a writing project that took place over the course of the school year. Leaders had found that teachers were confident in their reading assessments but, due to its subjectivity and scope, teachers were less confident in the assessment of writing and the challenges that this can bring. When seeking out support, staff often found they received conflicting advice, especially with regards to defining "greater depth" writers.

To address these concerns, the school reached out to One Education for support. Deborah Howard, headteacher at Oswald Road Primary School, explains 'we had worked with One Education before and it was a really positive experience. We also knew they had a strong reputation for their Literacy expertise and services.'

Our team collaborated with class teachers over the course of the academic year to boost their confidence in the teaching of writing and making accurate judgements within writing. We worked closely with each member of staff to understand their individual strengths and areas for development. Specifically, we focused on mid-year assessments, tracking pupil progress and identifying what children needed to do next within their writing to further develop and hone their craft.

With a background in curriculum development, moderation, and coaching, our team was able to share a wide range of strategies and skills with staff, helping them to identify how to use assessment to support children's progress and to feel more secure in their judgments, especially for children who were "on the cusp." Towards the end of the year, we supported the school's moderation process, where teachers were able to discuss their assessments and collectively develop a bank of annotated exemplars to support future practice.

THE ONE EDUCATION READING AWARD

The One Education Reading Award is a Reading quality standard for all schools and settings. It is the only reading quality mark which focuses on the full reading curriculum offered by schools. Whether you want to improve your reading offer or celebrate your achievements, the Reading Award offers a straightforward process designed to support your individual needs.

The award is designed for:

- Primary schools.
- Special schools, at both primary and secondary level.
- Settings that provide Alternative Provision.
- Secondary schools.
- All-through schools.

At the heart of the Reading Award are our accreditation documents, which guide schools to develop their reading provision. Our primary and secondary approaches are each split into three strands, ensuring children continue to build on prior learning as they progress through school.

Our primary approach

Reading for Decoding Reading for Understanding Reading for Enjoyment

Our secondary approach

Reading for Fluency Reading for Meaning Reading for Enjoyment

Each strand is broken down into key objectives, making next steps clear for those completing the award. The research-led criteria is annually updated in line with the latest developments in reading, with the support of our partner schools.

Schools can choose to work towards three levels of the Reading Award:

- Bronze: good provision is evident in Reading
- Silver: excellent provision is evident in Reading
- Gold: excellent provision is embedded across all areas of Reading









The Reading Award brings together amazing resources, online training, CPD, and opportunities to visit other schools, and is a truly supportive approach to continuous improvement.

Reading Award Packages

The One Education Reading Award can be purchased in three packages according to your school's needs.

Included in all packages are:


